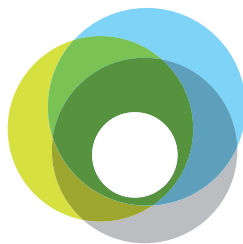

The development and investment in services for children, young people and families in recent years has meant that more support is available to parents and carers than ever before. However, many do not know how to access these services, or even that they exist.

NAPP's **Training for Referral** courses will enable participants to deliver high quality information and support whilst understanding that different approaches may be appropriate to meet the needs of particular groups.

These unique courses are essential for everyone who comes into contact with parents and carers, including:

- Frontline staff in schools and children's centres
- Early Years teams
- Childcare providers
- Health centre staff
- Library staff
- Leisure centre staff
- Learning mentors



Each course will run from 9am to 5pm, and will be led by approved National Academy for Parenting Practitioner trainers. The course utilises a range of learning techniques to ensure every participant gets the most out of the day.

By the end of each course, participants will:

- Learn how to listen effectively to parents and carers, and recognise when they are asking for help
- Know how and where to find out about local services for families
- Understand how to communicate effectively and sensitively with parents and carers
- Be able to signpost appropriate help and information, and encourage parents and carers to access support
- Build an appreciation of the needs of different groups of parents and carers

The courses are linked to the National Occupational Standards for work with parents and will be accredited by Edexcel (awaiting QCA approval).
