1) Election of officers

2) Getting 20 MPs/Lords signed up

A short discussion was held about the procedure for registering the group and the number needed. It was confirmed that we have about 20 people signed up and that we would register the group in the next 28 days. It was agreed everyone would ask other colleagues who might be interested to join as well.

3) Update on shout out for a sure start campaign

Anne Longfield gave an overview of the campaign, reported on the campaign launch, the website and social media presence and about building the

campaign up. Claire McCarthy talked about the importance of engaging the workforce in the campaign.

4) Priorities for the group

A discussion then took place about the issues and priorities for the group. Areas identified for discussion included how to improve centres' outreach systems and attract more disadvantaged families; how to ensure local services were 'joined up', how to address possible funding stream cuts; the governance of centres, the importance of the link with health services.

5) Mission Statement

It was agreed that 4Children would put together a draft mission statement to be circulated for comment.
